

"We live in a predominately farming area so any toxic fallout from the incinerator could be damaging for generations to come."

But, American energy bosses behind plans for the 32 megawatt plant, capable of burning up to 30,000 tonnes of waste a year, say emissions will be cleaned and concentration monitoring.

The Cheshire Anti-Incinerator Network (Chain) says the fallout from the scheme, proposed for the Midpoint 18 Business Park, could pose a health risk to thousands of families downwind.
